Camp Information

Pass Set Crush is an outdoor adventure camp with a concentration in volleyball. It is available for girls entering the 7th through 9th grades in the fall of 2025. Pass Set Crush offers a variety of activities in addition to two or three daily sessions of volleyball skills training and games. This unique summer camp experience includes: swimming, canoeing, kayaking, water carnival, beach BBQ dinner, Zumba, yoga, relaxation techniques, campfires with s'mores, and so much more!

Camp Tuition Information

The tuition is \$800 for all campers. This fee includes 5 days and 4 nights of housing, meals, instruction, recreational activities, plus a camp sweatshirt, and t-shirt. Enrollment is LIMITED. Space is limited to 48 campers per session and will be on a first registered basis. A \$500 deposit is required to reserve a space in camp (deadline for balance of \$300 is May 1st) or \$800 full payment when registering. Cancellation Policy: A full refund will be granted for requests made before May 1. After May 1, refunds will only be issued in the case of injury, with medical documentation provided by a health care provider.

Facilities and Features

Geneva Point Center is a 200-acre camp located on Lake Winnepesaukee in central New Hampshire. This special place offers beautiful views of the lake and the Ossipee Mountain range. This is the perfect spot for a summer camp experience. Geneva Point Center facilities include three outdoor volleyball courts, three beaches on Lake Winnepesaukee staffed with lifeguards, and a nurse on staff 24 hours a day.

Housing and Meals

Campers will be housed in cabins with supervision and they may choose a roommate upon applying. The dining room is located in a charming inn where three nutritious meals are served daily. There is also a camp store to purchase ice cream, drinks and snacks.

Director Joan Forge

Joan Forge is the Head Women's Volleyball Coach at Plymouth State University and was named the 2019 and 2021 Little East Conference Coach of the Year. Her team has won the LEC three years in a row with records of 32-5, 23-3, and 21-7. Joan previously coached at Gilford High School where she led her program to 15 state championships. She has been a teacher and coach of girls' sports for over 45 years. She brings with her an outstanding coaching staff.

The Coaching Staff

The campers will receive personal attention from our knowledgeable and enthusiastic staff that features high school and club head volleyball coaches as well as outstanding college and high school players from around the country. There is a 5:1 camper to staff ratio.
